CONCLUSION

The City desires through this Resolution to encourage congressional support for the renaming of the post office within the City, located at 5686 Fulton Industrial Blvd SW, Atlanta, GA 30336, in honor of the late and former Congressman Lewis.

BACKGROUND

Federal legislation renaming United States Postal Service (USPS) facilities for persons has become a common practice in the US. Renaming a USPS post office is overseen by the US House Oversight and Government Reform, Senate Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs committees requires unanimity of a state's congressional delegation and passage of the naming bill to the floor of the US House or Senate. In addition the renaming process does not change either the impacted facilities' services or identification of the facility by its geographic location.
