CONCLUSION

The City Council desires through this Resolution to adopt the City of South Fulton Historic and Cultural Landmarks Commission Bylaws and Rules of Procedure. The effective date of this Resolution shall be one week from the date of adoption, unless provided otherwise by the City Charter or state and/or federal law.

BACKGROUND

City Council has governing authority to put in place Bylaws that have the best interest of the health, safety and general welfare of the City and its employees, residents and visitors. The Powers and Duties of the Historic and Cultural Landmarks Commission are established in Section 5-7004, other applicable sections of the Code of City of South Fulton, and O.C.G.A. § 44-10-25.

There will be no financial impact to the FY21 budget and/or FY21 fiscal year appropriations/allocations unless additional enforcement will be needed.
