	WHEREAS , the duly elected governing authority of the City is the Mayor and Council thereof ("City Council");

	WHEREAS , on September 30, 2020, Governor Kemp signed an executive order (Executive Order 09.30.20.01) extending Georgia's Public Health State of Emergency due to COVID-19; and
	WHEREAS, as of the effective date of this Resolution, Georgia remains under a Public Health State of Emergency from COVID-19, with the number of new cases and related deaths increasing daily throughout Fulton County and Georgia;
	WHEREAS , the COVID-19 pandemic has placed tremendous hardship and burden upon governments and persons across the country, including the City, City operations and City employees and public safety personnel;
	WHEREAS , due to the current state of emergency and administrative burdens resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic, it remains unsafe for gatherings to occur in accordance with City issued special event permits;
34 35 36 37	WHEREAS , the City Council desires through this Resolution to place a temporary moratorium on the City's acceptance and granting of new applications for special event permits for the duration of Georgia's COVID-19 related Public Health State of Emergency; and
38 39	WHEREAS, this Resolution is in the best interests of the health, safety and general welfare of the City and State of Georgia.

40 THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOUTH FULTON, GEORGIA, HEREBY 41 RESOLVES as follows:

Section 1. Moratorium. The City Council hereby places a temporary moratorium 42 on the City's acceptance, processing and granting of applications for special event 43 permits, from the effective date of this Resolution through the duration of the COVID-19 44 related Public Health State of Emergency declared by the Georgia Governor. City staff 45 shall not accept, process and/or grant any application for a special event permit for the 46 effective duration of this Resolution. Any persons and/or entity with a pending and/or 47 48 approved special event application during the effective period of this moratorium shall be entitled to a refund. 49

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52 <u>Section 2.</u> It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that: (a) All 53 sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this Resolution are or were, 54 upon their enactment, believed by the City Council to be fully valid, enforceable and 55 constitutional.

(b) To the greatest extent allowed by law, each and every section, paragraph, sentence,
clause or phrase of this Resolution is severable from every other section, paragraph,
sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution. No section, paragraph, sentence, clause
or phrase of this Resolution is mutually dependent upon any other section, paragraph,
sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution.

(c) In the event that any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this Resolution
shall, for any reason whatsoever, be declared invalid, unconstitutional or otherwise
unenforceable by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, it is
the express intent of the City Council that such invalidity, unconstitutionality or
unenforceability shall, to the greatest extent allowed by law, not render invalid,
unconstitutional or otherwise unenforceable any of the remaining phrases, clauses,
sentences, paragraphs or sections of the Resolution.

68 <u>Section 3.</u> The City Attorney and City Clerk are authorized to make non-substantive 69 editing and renumbering revisions to this Resolution for proofing, codification, and 70 supplementation purposes. The final version of all resolutions shall be filed with the City 71 Clerk.

72 **Section 4.** This moratorium shall not apply to official City events.

<u>Section 5.</u> The effective date of this Resolution shall be the date of adoption, unless
 provided otherwise by the City Charter or state and/or federal law.
