### **CONCLUSION**

The City Council desires through this Resolution to place a temporary moratorium on the City's acceptance and granting of new applications for special event permits for the duration of Georgia's COVID-19 related Public Health State of Emergency.

### **BACKGROUND**

The City of South Fulton as well as governments across the world are responding in an emergency capacity to an outbreak of a respiratory disease caused by novel coronavirus ("COVID-19"). On September 30, 2020, Governor Kemp signed an executive order (Executive Order 09.30.20.01) extending Georgia's Public Health State of Emergency due to COVID-19. The number of new cases and related deaths are increasing daily throughout Fulton County and all of Georgia.

### **FINANCIAL IMPACT**

There will be no financial impact to the FY21 budget and/or FY21 fiscal year appropriations/allocations.
