10 11 12 13	WHEREAS, the City of South Fulton ("City") is a municipal corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Georgia;
13 14 15	WHEREAS , the duly elected governing authority of the City, is the Mayor and Council thereof ("City Council");
16 17 18	WHEREAS , the City Council is authorized pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 36-35-3 and other applicable laws to amend the City Charter;
19 20	WHEREAS , the City Treasurer currently serves a dual role as the Chief Financial Officer;
21 22 23 24 25	WHEREAS , the City Council desires through this Ordinance to eliminate the position of City Treasurer from the City Charter and have such position solely known as the Chief Financial Director, who shall serve under the direction of the City Manager; and
25 26 27	WHEREAS , the City Council finds that this Ordinance is in the best interests of the health and general welfare of the City, its residents and general public.
28 29 30 31 32 33	THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOUTH FULTON HEREBY ORDAINS as follows: Section 1. The City of South Fulton Charter, Section 4.14, Treasurer, is hereby amended by deleting the same in its entirety and replacing it with a new Section 4.14 titled "Reserved" as follows:

39 40 41 42 43	The mayor shall nominate and the city council shall confirm by a majority vote a city treasurer to collect all taxes, licenses, fees, and other moneys belonging to the city subject to the provisions of this Charter and the ordinances of the city and to enforce all laws of Georgia relating to the collection of delinquent taxes and sale or foreclosure for nonpayment of taxes to the city. The city treasurer shall also be responsible for the

- general duties of a treasurer and fiscal officer. The city council shall provide for the 44 compensation of the treasurer. 45 Section 2. The City of South Fulton Code of Ordinances, Title 1, Administration, 46 Chapter 6, Municipal Employees, Sec. 1-6007(2), Appointments, is hereby amended as 47 follows: 48 Title 1 - Administration 49 **Chapter 6. – Municipal Employees** 50 Sec. 1-6007. - Appointment and removal of department heads and directors 51 52 53 (2) Appointments and Removal. The appointment and removal of department heads and directors shall be governed as follows: 54 a. The city treasurer, who shall also serve as the chief finance officer, shall report to 55 the city council under both roles, and be responsible for the daily supervision, 56 hiring and removal of all department heads and directors under the city finance 57 department. 58 a. All other department heads and directors shall be hired and removed by the city 59 manager, and shall serve under the daily supervision of the city manager or 60 his/her designee. 61 62 Section 3. The duties of the Chief Financial Officer shall include all those duties set 63 forth under Section 4.14 of the City Charter prior to this amendment. The Human 64 Resources Department shall incorporate such duties into the job description of the Chief 65 Financial Officer. 66 67 **Section 4.** Until such time as the City Code is amended, all references to the City 68 69 Treasurer throughout the City Code and City documents shall refer to the Chief Financial Officer. 70 71 ******* 72
 - <u>Section 5.</u> It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that: (a) All sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this Ordinance are or were, upon their enactment, believed by the City Council to be fully valid, enforceable and constitutional.

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(b) To the greatest extent allowed by law, each and every section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is severable from every other section,

paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance. No section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is mutually dependent upon any other section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution.

- (c) In the event that any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this Ordinance shall, for any reason whatsoever, be declared invalid, unconstitutional or otherwise unenforceable by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, it is the express intent of the City Council that such invalidity, unconstitutionality or unenforceability shall, to the greatest extent allowed by law, not render invalid, unconstitutional or otherwise unenforceable any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs or sections of the Ordinance.
- **Section 6.** All Ordinance and Resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed.
- <u>Section 7.</u> The City Attorney, City Clerk and contracted City Codifier are authorized to make non-substantive formatting and renumbering edits to this ordinance for proofing, codification, and supplementation purposes. The final version of all ordinances shall be filed with the City Clerk.
- **Section 8.** The effective date of this Ordinance shall be as set forth under the City Charter and O.C.G.A. § 36-35-3, unless provided otherwise by applicable local, state and/or federal law.
